




Steps:

- 1) Connect assembled panels [1/2] & [3/4] together, with Infill Panel [7] inserted.
- 2) Attach Door Panels [5,6] to assembled counter body.
- 3) Install Legs to bottom of counter using bolts
- 4) Connect threaded stud of Standoff Barrels to nutserts in Counter Top, as shown in detail.
- 5) Attach Counter Top to top panel using bolts as shown.


** Note: Panels [1-2] and [3-4] are permanently connected with a hinge.




BACK VIEW

General Setup Instructions

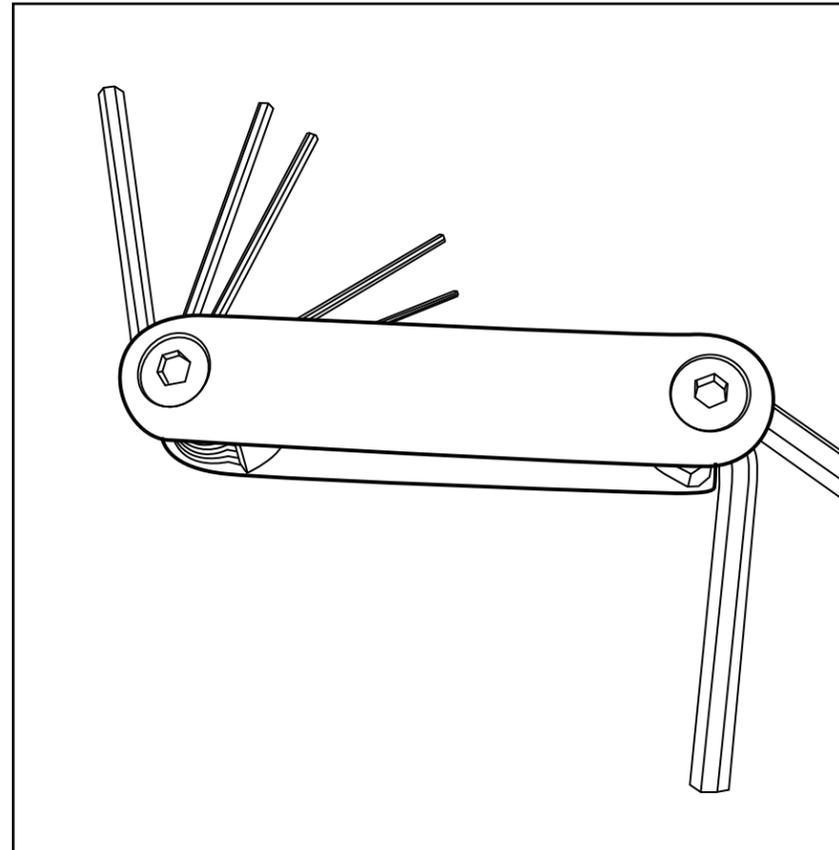
- The setup instructions are created specifically for your configuration.
- Setup instructions are laid out sequentially in levels, including exploded views and a logical series of steps for assembly. We encourage you to study the instructions before attempting to assemble your exhibit.

Cleaning and Packing


- Use non-abrasive cleaners when cleaning extrusions or ECO Glass inserts.
- Use mild cleaners and soft materials such as cotton to clean all laminates.
- Keep exhibit components away from extreme heat and long exposure to sun light. This will prevent warping and fading.
- Retain all packing material for ease of re-packing. This protects the exhibit components and keeps each part organized.

Disassembling

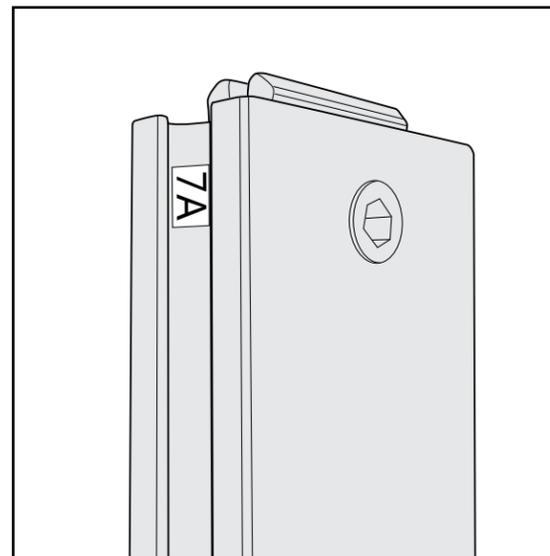
- When disassembling exhibit, tighten all setscrews to prevent loss of hardware in the shipping process.



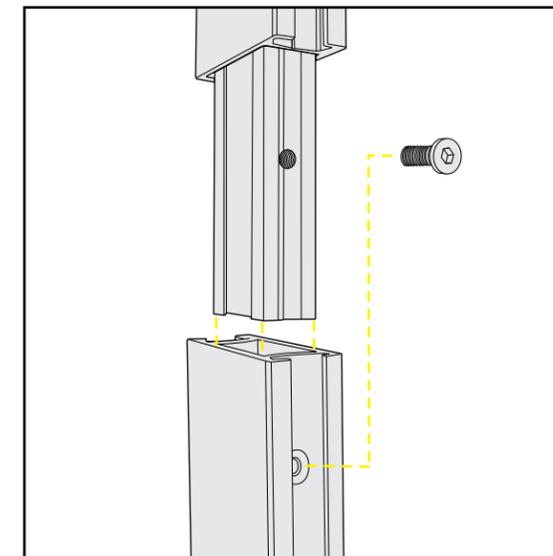
Hex Tool for Assembling Exhibit




Extrusion Lock Connectors



Numbering Instructions for Setups/Packing




Inline Connection between Extrusions




Baseplate Connection for Vertical Extrusions


Top View of Each Level






